DAY OF MONTH MAY OF YEAR 2017 AT CHENNAI.**

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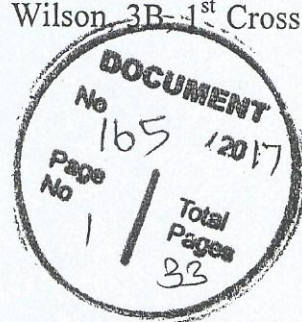

A. Those persons whose names and descriptions are set forth hereto, together with such other persons as from time to time may become Trustees, jointly and severally known as and hereinafter called "**the Trustees**" (*which expressions shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to include the survivors or survivor of them and the trustees or trustee for the time being of these presents and their heirs, executors and administrators of the last surviving trustee, their or his/her assignees*) of the other part;

Trustees shall mean and include the Board of Trustees, if any, as described in these presents, and these Trustees, as appointed, nominated or selected by the remaining members of the Board of Trust whenever any vacancy arises.

The Settlor(s) and the Trustee(s) have been successfully managing and administering education and charitable institutions of repute for over two decades and have a reputation for public and charitable services being rendered by them for several decades including for the poor and the needy public at large.

The Settlor(s) are desirous of establishing a **TRUST** with an object to establish, acquire and administer Pre-schools, Schools, Colleges, Libraries, Hostels and other Educational Institutions.

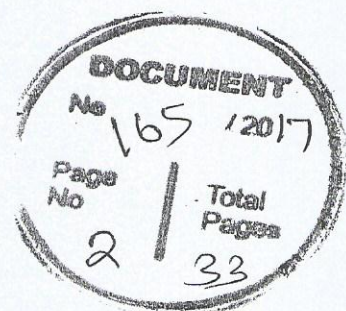
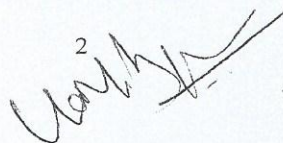
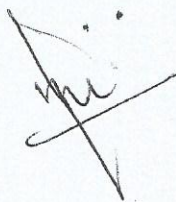
The Settlor(s) have discussed and outlined the features of the proposed **TRUST** in the interim meeting of the Settlor(s) and has since been agreed to be reduced in writing.

The Settlor(s) thus have decided to establish an **EDUCATIONAL TRUST** to be known as the '**St. John's Christ's Educational Trust**' ("**the Trust**") for the purposes of providing for education to the public at large without any distinction as to religion, region, language, caste, colour, race, creed or gender.

The Trustees contemplate that they will from time to time receive sums of money, deeds and property to be held by them for the purposes of the Trust ("**the Trust Property**").

WHEREAS the Settlor(s) decided to create and establish an Educational Trust solely for Charitable purpose more fully described in the ensuing paras for the welfare of public at large without discrimination as to religion, region, race, language, caste, creed, sect, gender with objects and constitution as hereinafter set forth;

WHEREAS the Settlor(s) with a keen and earnest desire of founding the Educational Trust for public charitable purposes are desirous of donating for the present, a sum of Rs.1,00,000 (rupees one lakh only) each, in all aggregating to Rs.2,00,000 (rupees two lakhs only);



WHEREAS in pursuance of their desire above said the Settlor(s) hereby irrevocably settles the sum of Rs. 2,00,000 (rupees two lakh only) on the Trustees as an initial settlement of the Trust viz., Cheque No.203957 for Rs.1,00,000/- dated 26.5.2017, Cheque No.203958 for Rs.1,00,000/- dated 26.5.2017, both drawn on State Bank of India, Neelankarai, East Coast Road, Chennai-600041, India;

WHEREAS the said Settlor(s) hereby declare(s) that the said sum of money set apart by them is being handed over by them to the Trustees mentioned herein above for purpose described hereinafter and for the sole purpose that it should form corpus fund of the Trust;

WHEREAS the Trustee(s) agree to act as Trustees on the terms set out in this Deed; and

WHEREAS it is considered necessary and expedient to record the terms of the trust in writing.

Now, **THEREFORE, THIS DEED OF TRUST is executed by the SETTLOR(S) of the TRUST and WITNESSTH AS FOLLOWS:**

TERMS OF THIS DEED

1. Trusts

1.1

The Trustees shall hold the Trust Property in Perpetuity or until the Trust is sooner wound up in accordance with the terms hereof, upon the trusts and subject to the terms and conditions set out in this Trust Deed.

2. Name

The name of the Trust shall be the 'St. John's Christ's Educational Trust'.

3. Registered Office

The Registered office of the Trust shall be at 3B, 1st Cross Street, Annasalai, Palavakkam, Chennai-600041, India. The place is owned by Mrs. Nalini Wilson (Settlor).

4. Objects

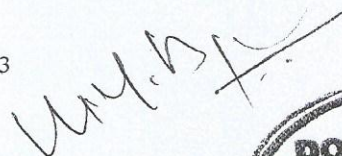
The Objects and purposes for which the Trust is established are:

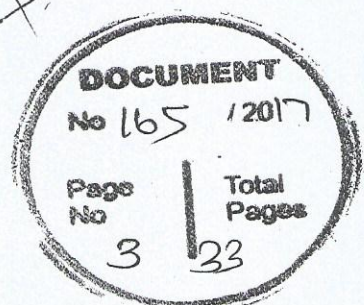
4.1.1

To establish, acquire, maintain, support, run Pre-Schools, Schools, Colleges and Educational institutions and centers or other institutions in the field of research, science, arts, technical, vocational, culture of the like in India for the student and the staff and also for the development, advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst all and general public without distinction of religion, region, race, language, caste, creed, sect, gender.

4.1.2

To provide, pay for provision of free education, schemes, studentships, scholarships, support, render other types of aids to students including supply of books, notebooks, cloths, uniforms, stipends, grants and other incentives to study, and grant aid or other financial assistance. To establish, administer, assist, run free, concessional or subsidized-hostels, library, clinic, crèche, hostels, bible college, balwadis, tuition center, B.Ed. college, counselling center, retreat center, coaching center, student homes for the students and weaker sections of Society.

4.1.3.

To setup schools, colleges, and other educational institutions including but not limited to providing for basic, primary, secondary, higher, technical, vocational, scientific, advanced, professional education in any stream for charitable purposes.

4.1.4

To start research centers and institutions of the like nature in India or abroad, for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and to improve quality education by preparation and usage of innovative learning material and adopting scientific teaching, techniques, and technologies through remedial education classes.

4.1.5

To provide, promote education, food, clothing, shelter, and/or provide accommodation or home or dwelling(s) or place(s) to live to the deserving, needy, helpless, indigent and destitute students/children, in the spirit of nation building. To create opportunities of imparting moral education for enculturation of the students, so as to make them active, responsible and faithful citizens of the nation.

4.1.6

Generally, to do all things necessary and desirable to achieve the aims set out in these Objects and elsewhere in this deed to the intent that the declaration of Objects shall not be exclusive and may at any time be extended to permit the Trust to give such assistance in other ways to person(s) or bodies who are undertaking initiatives consistent with the Objects of the Trust.

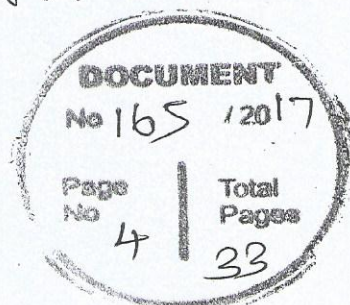
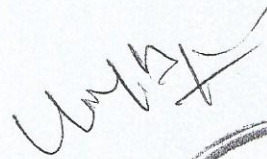
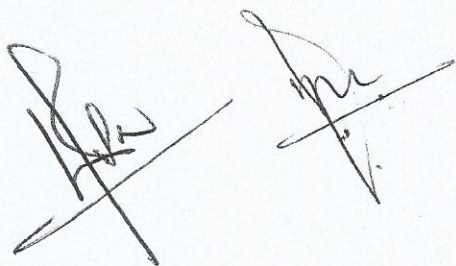
Provided that nothing herein before or after contained shall authorise any object that is not Charitable in Law and/or intended to make profit(s).

4.1.7

To solicit, obtain, accept, offering, subscriptions, sponsorships, donations, grants, aids, contributions, gifts, legacies, devices and bequests, in cash or in kind including immovable property without any encumbrance, from the Settlor(s), any person, firm, company, bodies corporate, legal entities, NGO's, trusts, Charitable Trusts, charitable institutions interested in any of the objects of the Trust. ***Subject that the Trustees shall not accept any receipts with any conditions or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trust.***

4.1.8

To acquire by gifts, purchase, exchange, lease, on hire or otherwise howsoever any lands, buildings, easement, rights of common playgrounds, parks and property moveable and immovable any estate or interest, in the name of/for and on behalf of the Trust, for the furtherance of all or any other objects of the Trust.



4.1.9

To do any lawful act(s) nationally and internationally that advances the above charitable aims and are not inconsistent with the Trust objectives.

4.1.10

For the avoidance of doubt, the objects of the Trust expressed herein are set out in no particular order or priority.

5. Declaration

5.1

The Trust 'St. John's Christ's Educational Trust', is hereby declared to be a Public Charitable Trust and that all the objects of the Trust are for Public Charitable Purposes, all the provisions of this declaration are to be construed accordingly.

5.2

If any of the objects, in whole or in part or any other provision of this declaration is found to be repugnant or inconsistent with any of the said provisions as are applicable on the relevant date, such objects or provisions shall be deemed to be cancelled to the extent of such repugnance or inconsistency and if any of the object of the Trust is found to be invalid on the ground of vagueness or any other reason by a competent authority, it shall be deemed to have not been included in the objects of the Trust so as to effect the validity of the Trust.

5.3

Nothing containing in this declarations shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed as violative or contrary to the provisions of section 2(15), 11, 12, 12-A, 13, 10(23C), 80-G or any other relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modifications thereof, and all activities of the Trust shall be carried on with a view to benefit the public at large without any profit motive for charitable purposes only as may be permissible under the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or the statutory modifications thereof. The Settlor(s) of this Trust are hereby expressly authorised to add any other charitable objects in the objects of the Trust provided, however it is a charitable object within the meaning of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

5.4

That the Trust created is irrevocable.

6. Benefits of the Trust

The benefits of the Trust shall be for any Citizen and/or Resident of India irrespective of religion, region, race, language, caste, creed, sect, gender. That the Trust will not carry on any activities with an intention of earning profit. Provided further that all such benefits, whether monetary or otherwise which shall/may accrue as a result of such service provided shall vest/accrue/inure only to the Trust at all times.

7. Powers of the Trust/ Trustee(s)

General Powers:

7.1

Subject to the provisions of the Trust Deed, and in particular the objects stated herein and the resolution requirements, the Trustees shall have all the powers over and in respect of the Trust and the Trust Assets which they could exercise if they were the absolute and beneficial owners of the Trust Assets. In particular, without in any way limiting the wide powers conferred by the foregoing, the Trustees shall have full and absolute power to do including but not limited to the following:
