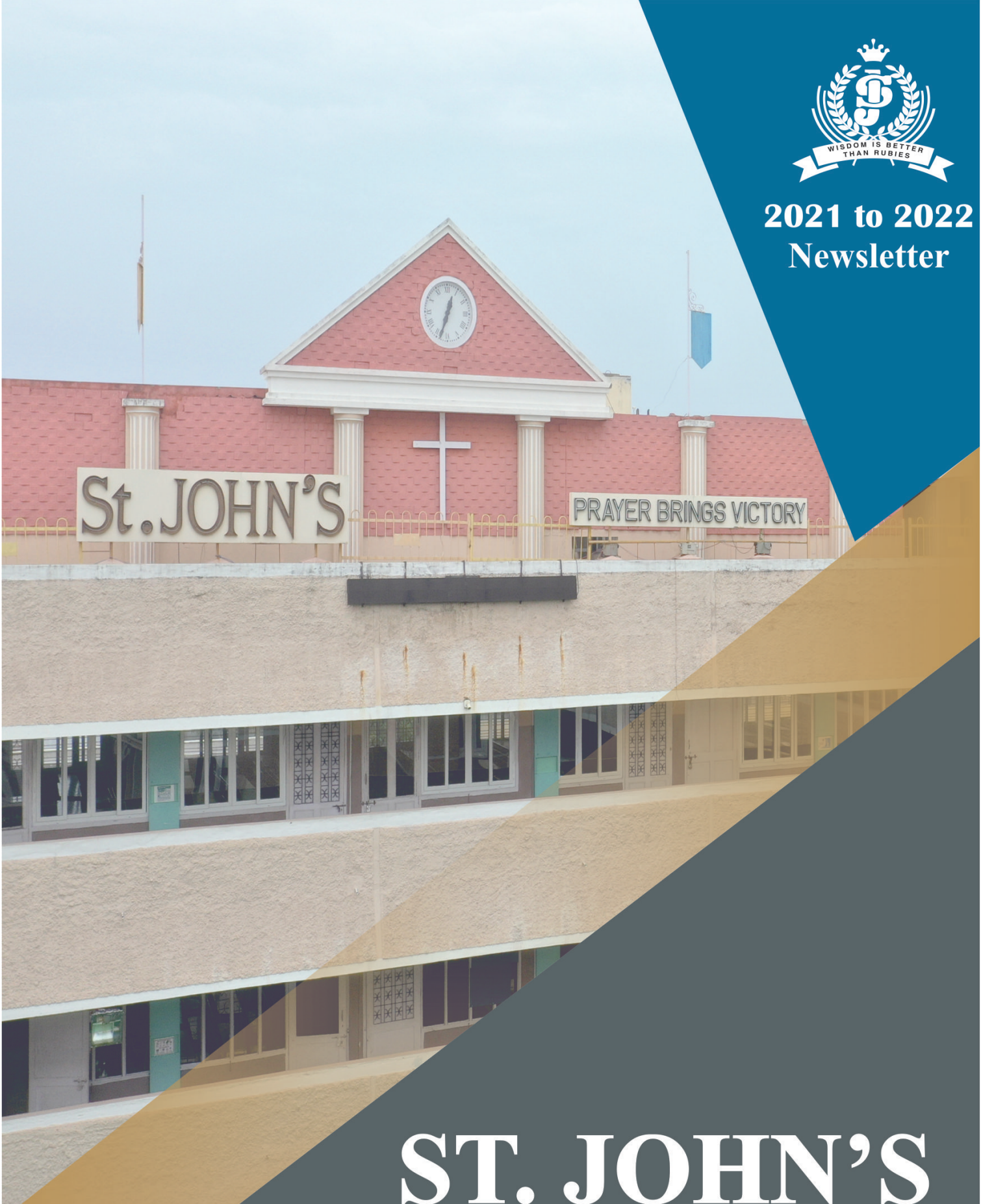

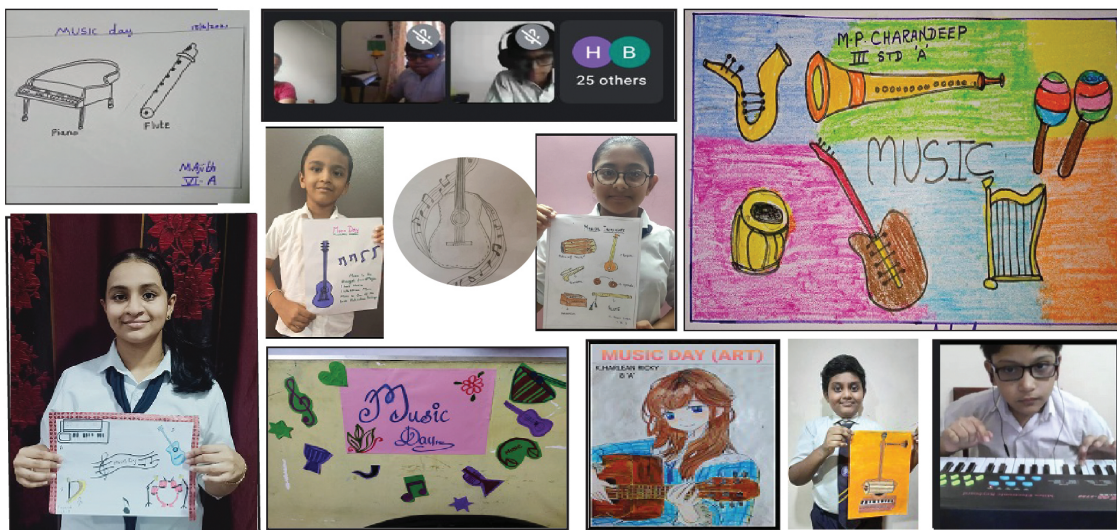
Bell day

Covid -19 Awareness Drive:



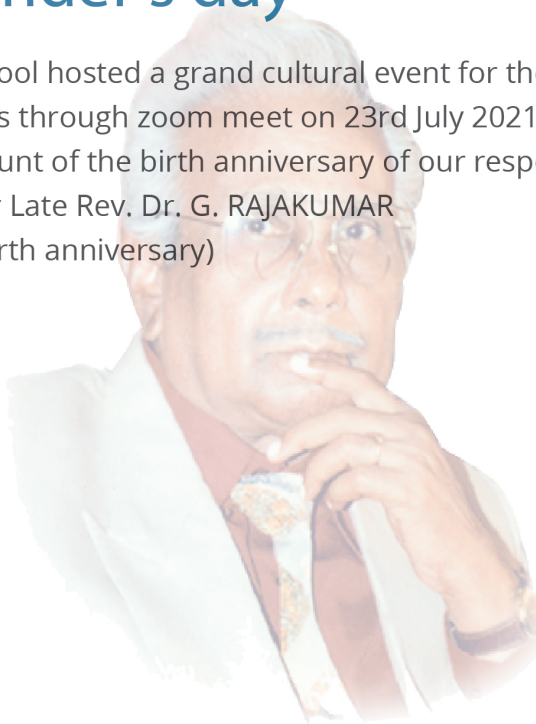
Following State government's declaratives our School students conducted Covid-19 Awareness Program for 10 days starting from the 1st of July. The various activities done during that period are:

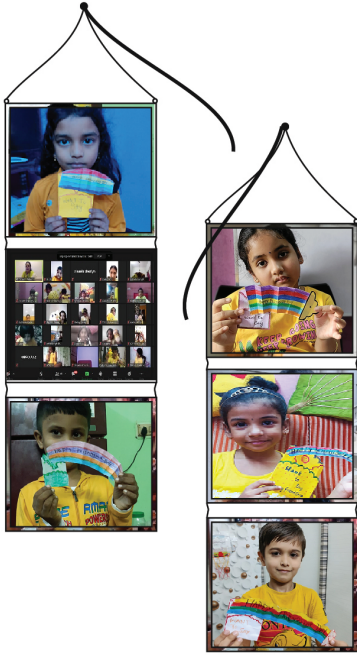

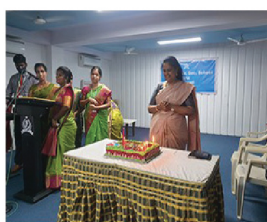


Celebrations

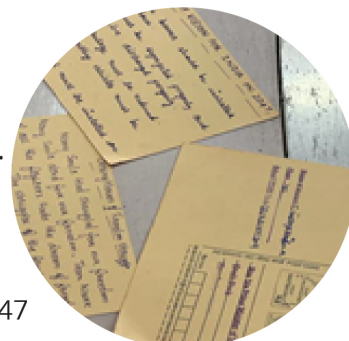
White Gifts Distribution:

Reading Mission

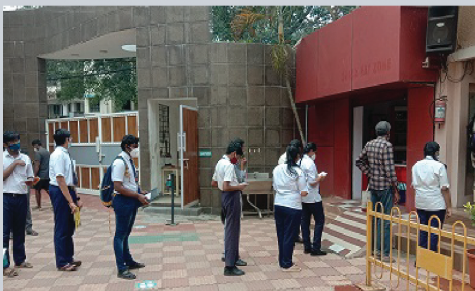

Just as the pandemic started unfolding paralysing daily activities and bringing uncertainties the question foremost in our minds was 'how could the kids continue their education?'

Well there is a saying that 'When the going gets tough, the tough get going!' and this was proved right by our school, St Johns.

Leveraging on technology, the school was quick to set up online classes for the children.

The situation was unprecedented and therefore no one had any experience to deal with it or could prepare. To me it was not just about starting to teach in front of a camera instead of a live class of students but the planning behind setting up the whole thing that mattered the most. If preparing the IT infrastructure (hardware and online learning platform) was important, so was scheduling the timing for the classes - balancing the attention span of students as well as fatigue while managing the biological needs.

On the other hand, the teachers were constrained without a writing board and had to resort to alternate arrangements and extra efforts to illustrate the lessons to the students. Though smart phones had already invaded most households even before the pandemic, for parents it was still a daunting task to arrange devices for the children, set up the account and online platform and subsequently manage all interfaces. Coming to the most important stakeholder - the students, who are the beneficiaries of the learning, this experience was a very different one. But the students took it on their stride and offered their cooperation. Looking back, this was a clear demonstration of collaboration and teamwork among all stakeholders - the school management, the staff, the parents and the students.

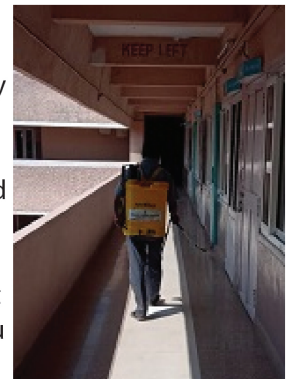
